The Internal SSD drive will help processing speed and operation of Inv. Darin Morrissey's newer Dell workstation laptop.

The Cellebrite 4pc upgrade is required due to the current Cellebrite hardware UFED Touch utilized by Inv. Darin Morrissey is being discontinued and will soon be un-supported for updates through Cellebrite. Cellebrite is the primary hardware and software for processing cellular phones, tablet and other portable devices at the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office.
