<p>Proposed Ordinance of the City of Gretna</p> <p>PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: The Nebraska Legislature adopted Section 71-3305 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes requiring the fluoridation of water systems of all cities above 1,000 in population. If a municipality chooses <u>not</u> to fluoridate its water, it is required that a vote of the people decide the issue.</p> <p>A "yes" vote will authorize the City of Gretna, Nebraska, to adopt an ordinance to <u>prohibit the addition of fluoride</u> into the Gretna water system. If you do not want the City of Gretna to fluoridate its water system, vote "YES".</p> <p>A "no" vote will <u>require the fluoridation</u> of the Gretna water system.
