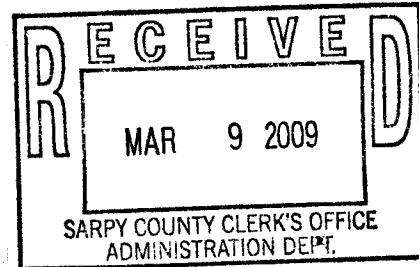

NOTICE OF HIGHWAY INFORMATION MEETING

Public Information Open House

The Nebraska Department of Roads will hold a public information open house regarding modifications of the intersection of Nebraska Highway 50 (N-50) & Cornhusker Road, north of Interstate 80 (I-80), and the intersection of N-50 & Meadows Parkway. The meeting is to be held at the Chalco Hills Recreation Area Natural Resource Center, March 31, 2009, 4-6 P.M. Design plans will be displayed. Personnel from NDOR will be present to answer questions and receive comments about the proposed project. There will be no formal presentation.

HSIP-50-2(132), N-50/Cornhusker Road & N-50/Meadows Parkway Intersections Modifications, involves improvements to the east side of both intersections.

The plan for the Cornhusker Road intersection at 142nd Street South includes channelizing the westbound approach to N-50. This improvement includes a raised median and radius modifications to limit turning from the north-south frontage road, just east of the intersection.

Additional improvements are planned for the Meadows Parkway intersection with N-50, approximately a quarter of a mile north of Cornhusker Road. These modifications will allow large trucks to make a right-hand turn onto the frontage road (143rd Ave. S.) from Meadows Parkway to access the businesses east of N-50.

The project, located primarily on existing alignment, will alleviate some congestion at the Cornhusker Road intersection and provide improved traffic flow.

Construction is located entirely in Sarpy County and will require no detours during construction. Acquisition of new right-of-way will be minimal. There will be no impact to wetlands.

The public meeting is being held to provide information and receive input regarding these improvements. All citizens are invited to attend and present relevant comments and questions. Final roadway designs and right-of-way plans will be developed after this open house information meeting.

Where possible, NDOR will provide a meeting facility accessible to all persons. Appropriate provisions for people who are physically challenged in any manner or who have low English proficiency will be made if the Department is notified by April 6, 2009.
