**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH
A LAW REGARDING FALSE ALARMS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-104(6), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the county necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-103, the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-187(1)(f), the County may regulate, through ordinance, false alarms from electronic security systems that result in requests for emergency response from law enforcement or other emergency responders; and,

WHEREAS, under the direction of the County Board, the County Administrator and County Attorney drafted an ordinance to establish a law regarding false alarms from electronic security systems that result in requests for emergency response; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-188, notice was published in a newspaper of general circulation once per week for two weeks and such notice contained the entire language of the ordinance and the time and place of the hearing; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-188, a public hearing on the ordinance was held on November 11, 2018; and,


WHEREAS, in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-192, the County Clerk provided a copy of the ordinance to the clerk of each city no later than seven days from the date of the public hearing and each city was given seven days to respond; and,

WHEREAS, a motion was made to proceed to final adoption of the ordinance to establish a law regarding false alarms from electronic security systems that result in requests for emergency response; and,

WHEREAS, the County Board desires to adopt an ordinance to establish a law regarding false alarms from electronic security systems that result in requests for emergency response, a copy of which is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that this Board does hereby adopt the ordinance to establish a law regarding false alarms from electronic security systems that result in requests for emergency response, a copy of which is attached hereto.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with the applicable law on the 27th day of November, 2018.
